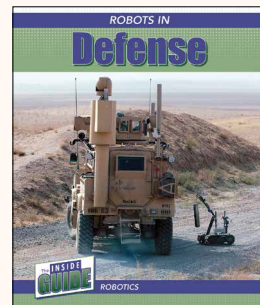
INSECT CYBORGS

DARPA has been trying to create tiny drones called micro air vehicles (MAVs) since the 1940s. However, engineers realized that insects and small flying mammals are already some of the best MAVs around. Engineers and scientists began exploring the idea of developing HI-MEMs, or Hybrid Insect Micro-Electro-Mechanical systems. Scientists would insert mechanical parts into baby bugs to make them half-insect and half-machine—insect cyborgs. Modifying the insect's body would let a person control its behavior and capture images from the sky. These cyborg insects could be important in reconnaissance and surveillance missions because no one would suspect them, and they could fit into small spaces.
