Desert animals such as gray foxes are nocturnal, or active at night when it's cooler. Others are more active at dawn and dusk.

deserts, such as the Sahara in Africa, are very hot. Temperatures often dip low at night and rise greatly during the day.

Animals have had to adapt to life in deserts. To beat the heat, some animals—like pack rats and Gila monsters—dig holes called burrows. They stay underground for the hottest parts of the day. It's cooler there.

A desert's lack of water is a major challenge. Some animals need very little water to survive, which is an adaptation. For example, kangaroo rats survive eating mostly dry seeds, with no water available.

Water World
More than 70 percent of Earth is water! Many animals live in bodies of water. Some animals live in the ocean, which is salty. Others live in

Polar bears have the thickest fur of any bear on Earth. The top layer is made of clear, hollow tubes that trap air for insulation.

Some animals, such as the grizzly bear, rest through the long, cold winters. Their bodies "shut down" for months to save energy. During this time, their heart rate and breathing slow down.

Desert Creatures
Deserts are also extreme habitats. They are very dry, gaining no more than 10 inches (25.4 centimeters) of rain or snow per year. Many
