### America's Great Divide

Meanwhile, the vote in midsize and small metro areas also swing to the Democrats after two elections in which they lost ground to the Republicans. These areas are still majority-Republican, but 61 percent of them saw swings to Trump in 2020.

It is interesting to note that while Trump's margins shifted in many counties, not all of them "turned blue" this year. Of the 1,246 counties that swung to Biden, Trump held on to 9 percent of them.

It's possible, however, that this picture could change when the final tallies are in.

### RURAL AMERICA IS UNDERSERVED BY POLITICISTS AND PHILANTHROPISTS

Ask Americans what parts of the country are the most poverty-stricken, and they'll likely answer "inner city" or "rural areas like West Virginia, St. Louis, and St. Louis." They aren't. Body and soul, rural areas in states like Mississippi, New Mexico, and Arkansas.

They are, in fact, the most deprived in rural America than in urban America. According to the most recent data from the National Center for Health Statistics, the rural poverty rate was 12.5 percent, while the poverty rate in nonmetropolitan areas was 11.8 percent.

And poverty is just one of the areas where there is a divide between urban and rural. ### According to a U.S. government study of more than 200 of the largest U.S. foundations, the average real value of grants from foundations to rural areas increased from \$100 million in 2005 to \$150 million in 2010, while the average \$100 per capita grant to organizations in nonmetropolitan areas remained flat.

Why do so many U.S. philanthropists ignore rural areas, and what can be done about it? That's the question that motivates the authors of *Philanthropy's Rural Blind Spot*, set to release in the fall of 2023. In the Spring 2023 issue of the *Social Innovation Review*, one of the leading journals for social innovation, the U.S. foundations' giving gap to the largest U.S. foundations in nonmetropolitan areas was 10 percent.

There are, of course, community foundations based in rural areas, but they are smaller than their urban counterparts. Most grants from foundations in rural areas go to nonprofits working on creating awareness about and also addressing modern slavery.

Reparations Could Help an American Dream Deferred

That we all have an equal opportunity to generate the kind of wealth that brings meaning to the words "life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness" is a core tenet of the American Dream. The American Dream pretends that with hard work, a person can own a home, start a business, and grow a nest egg for retirement. It also promises that everyone will have an equal chance to succeed regardless of the color of their skin or the place they were born. That was the promise of the United States government when it came up with the GI Bill after World War II. The GI Bill provided education, housing, and business ownership opportunities for returning veterans and their families. It also provided for the first time in history for racial equality in education, housing, and business ownership. In addition, it provided for the first time in history for the bodies of enslaved Black Americans to be used as free labor and to be compensated for their work.





Most readers of this piece are likely quite satisfied with the current state of the media. They probably also are collegial, educated, have a job that lets them work remotely, and live in a nice neighborhood.

According to William "Sandy" Darity and Derrick Bell, production. This was more money than was invested in factories and railroads combined. In 1861, the white placed on cotton produced \$1 billion in revenue. By 1865, the South had freed white slave owners and their descendants, and fuelled the country's economy while suppressing wealth building for the enslaved. The Union army had to pay for the slaves to be freed, and the federal government had to pay for the land given to Black Americans for their labor. Not only did the federal government allow the land to be taken from anti-black housing, transportation, and business leaders, they also gave the same land to anti-black politicians like railroad and other discriminatory public policies. In contrast, the federal government provided Black Americans with opportunities to build wealth (defined as assets minus debts) afforded to their white peers.

Today, the media continues to exacerbate racial divides. As economist William "Sandy" Darity and Derrick Bell point out in their book *Is Inequality Obstructing the American Dream?*, "Blacks cannot close the racial wealth gap by changing their individual behavior—i.e., by assuming more personal responsibility for their financial well-being—because they are associated with [financial] toxicity." In fact, white high school depositors have more wealth than Black college graduates. However, the study found that Black students who graduated from college came from a lack of financial capital.

The media continues to reveal failings in the American Dream. The financial and social consequences are significant and wide-ranging. Wealth is positively correlated with better health, longer life expectancy, and higher educational attainment. Assets from home, stocks, bonds, and retirement savings provide a financial safety net for the inevitable short-term setbacks and personal challenges that come with living a normal life. Recessions impact everyone, but wealth is distributed quite unevenly. In 2008, Black Americans lost more wealth than white Americans to the economic downturn in the wake of economic disasters like the 2008 housing crisis and natural ones like Hurricane Katrina in 2005. Those who can draw upon the equity
