CHAPTER SIX: PLASTIC POLLUTION

About 71 percent of Earth is covered by water. A lot of plastic gets into the world's oceans each year. People who study plastic waste think between 8.8 million and 20 million tons (8 million and 18.1 million mt) of plastic winds up in the oceans every year.

An item that a person only uses once before throwing it away is called a single-use item. Plastic bottles, straws, and bags are all single-use items. About 40 percent of all plastic waste is single-use items.

Plastic has started to clump together in the oceans. In 1997, a sailor named Charles Moore discovered the **Great Pacific Garbage Patch** between Hawaii and California. Today, about 87,000 tons (79,000 mt) of plastic are in the Great Pacific Garbage Patch. Most of it is old fishing gear.

From Big to Small

Crustaceans vary greatly in their shapes and sizes. The heaviest crustacean is the American lobster. It can reach a weight of 44 pounds (20 kg). The longest crustacean is the giant Japanese spider crab. Its legs can stretch up to 12 feet (3.7 m). Other crustaceans can be very large too. The Tasmanian giant crab can weigh as much as 31 pounds (14 kg). The average weight of the Alaskan king crab is 10 pounds (4.5 kg), but it can grow to over 20 pounds (9 kg).



Most American lobsters are mottled brown, but some are bright blue or blue green.



This is a water flea. It would only take up the space of a tiny corner of your fingernail!

At the other end of the scale, water fleas, fairy shrimp, and brine shrimp are some of the smallest crustaceans. Most are shorter than 0.25 inch (6.4 mm). Water fleas may only grow to be 0.009 inch (0.23 mm) long. Although they're tiny in size, water fleas serve as an important food source for many freshwater fish.

What Is a Mollusk?

A mollusk is a type of animal with a soft, unsegmented (not in parts) body. Most mollusks have a hard shell that protects their body, but not all do. There are more than 100,000 species of mollusks in the world. Scientists think they account for 25 percent of all known sea animals.



The Ceratophan blue slug is a large land slug. It creeps around on grass, moss, and piles of leaves.



About 95 percent of all animals on Earth are invertebrates!

With so many mollusk species, it's no surprise how different they are. But they do have some traits, or things, in common. Mollusks are invertebrates, which means they do not have a backbone, and their bodies are not divided into clear sections. Generally, mollusks have three body regions—a head, a visceral mass, and a footlike structure. The head contains the brain. The visceral mass contains the organs. It is surrounded by a protective layer called the mantle. In some mollusks, the mantle forms the animal's shell. Its "foot" helps it to dig, grasp, and creep around.

THE BRIGADE SYSTEM

You may have noticed that many chef positions have French names. That's because traditional kitchen positions are based on a French system of organizing workers called the Brigade de Cuisine, or the Brigade System. In this system, workers are ranked so that the chain of command is clear. Work is completed by specialized chefs in an orderly and speedy manner.

In modern restaurants, some of the traditional roles are combined. Kitchen staff is usually ranked from highest to lowest, as shown on page 11.

A VISIBLE CRASH

Earth's magnetic field pushes the charged particles toward the north and south poles. Then, particles collide with, or crash into, the **atoms** in Earth's atmosphere. Driven by **energy** from the sun, these particles move very fast. The atoms they hit take on some of the particles' energy.

The atoms have too much energy after the charged particles hit them. This energy is released, and we see it as the colorful light of an aurora.

HITTING THE GROUND

Most meteors burn up in the atmosphere, so all that's left of them is a little bit of dust. However, if the meteor is big enough, part of it can fall to Earth. Meteors that reach Earth's surface are called meteorites.

The outside of a meteorite melts when it enters Earth's atmosphere, but it doesn't burn up completely. After it falls to Earth, a meteorite is cool enough to touch, though the outside will have been burned to a glossy black.

FUN FACT

THE STREAK OF LIGHT THAT SHOWS A METEOR'S PATH IN THE SKY IS CALLED THE METEOR TRAIL.

Most meteorites are very small. This picture shows an unusually large meteorite.
