In 1787, many **representatives** from most of the U.S. states arrived in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. They meant to change the first constitution they had created. The group soon decided the country needed a whole new constitution instead.

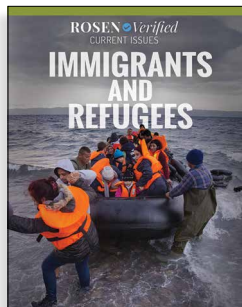
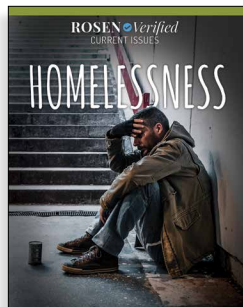
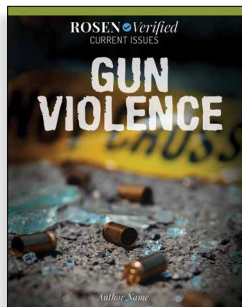
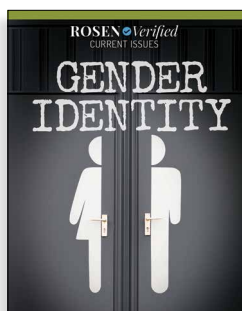
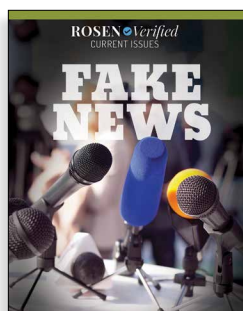
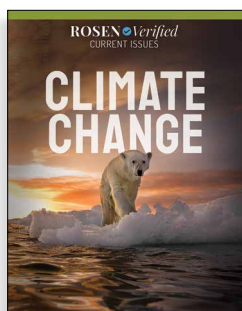
After much talking and arguing, the group came up with a new law of the land for the country. However, some representatives still didn't like it. They said the constitution needed a bill of rights. This is a list of individual rights and limits on government.

**GEORGE MASON**  
George Mason (1725-1792) was a representative from Virginia who took part in creating the U.S. Constitution. Before that, he wrote the Virginia Declaration of Rights. When the time came to OK the U.S. Constitution, Mason wouldn't do it. He wanted a bill of rights. He also didn't like the power it gave the federal government.

**THE ARTICLES OF CONFEDERATION**  
The Articles of Confederation was the first constitution of the United States. It went into effect in 1781. This constitution gave little power to the federal government. In time, the government was so weak it caused problems. That's why representatives met in 1787 to change things.

The representatives met in the Pennsylvania State House. It's now called Independence Hall.

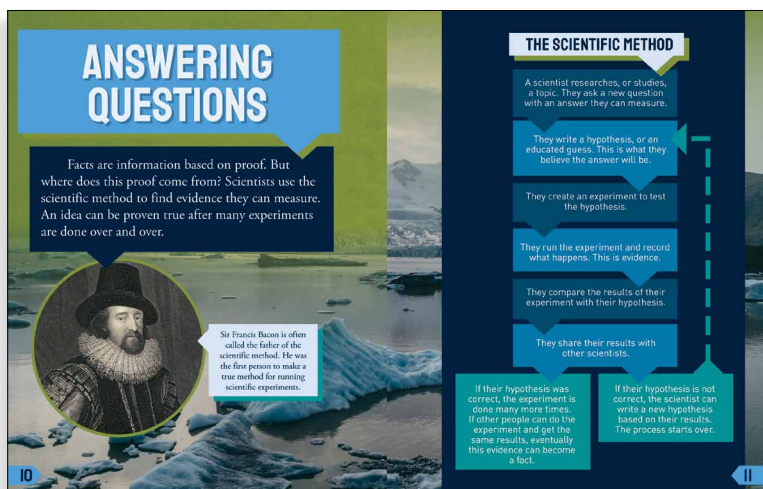

### WHO DECIDES?

The Supreme Court is the highest court in the United States. It reviews cases that have gone through other courts. It also settles cases between states or between a state and the federal government.

The Supreme Court can rule that a state law is unconstitutional. Sometimes, it decides that something that used to be legal shouldn't be. It can also decide that some things that used to be illegal should be legal.

There are nine Supreme Court judges. They're chosen by the president and approved by the Senate. The head of the Supreme Court is called the chief justice.

### SUPREME FIRSTS

**John Jay**  
The first chief justice of the Supreme Court was John Jay. He was appointed by President George Washington. He served from 1789 to 1795.

**Thurgood Marshall**  
Marshall was the first African American named to the Supreme Court. He was appointed by President Lyndon Johnson. He served from 1967 to 1991.

**Sandra Day O'Connor**  
O'Connor was the first woman named to the Supreme Court. She was appointed by President Ronald Reagan. She served from 1981 to 2006.

### NUMBERS AND THE ELECTORAL COLLEGE

Numbers are important in the Electoral College. On election night, campaign workers watch the following numbers carefully. So do the news media and voters.

#### ELECTORAL STEPS

- There are 538 electors. Each state has as many electors as they do members of Congress.
- To win as president, that candidate must have at least 270 electoral votes. This is more than half of the total votes.
- Every 10 years, the number of a state's electoral votes is updated. This keeps it up to date with changes in Congress.

### Beethoven's Unfinished 10th Symphony Brought to Life by Artificial Intelligence

By Teresa L. Carey

In 1988, musicologist Larry Cooper attempted. But he didn't get beyond the first movement. Beethoven's handwritten notes on the second and third movements are meager—not enough to compose a symphony.

**Werzowa:** A movement of a symphony can have up to 40,000 notes. And some of his themes were three bars, like 20 notes. It's very little information.

**Carey:** Werzowa and a group of music experts and computer scientists teamed up to use machine learning to create the symphony. Ahmed Elgammal, the director of the Art and Artificial Intelligence Laboratory at Rutgers University, led the AI side of the team.

**Elgammal:** When you listen to music read by AI to continue a theme of music, usually it's a very short few seconds, and then they start diverging and becoming boring and not interesting. They cannot really take that and compose a full movement of a symphony.

**Carey:** The team's first task was to teach the AI to think like Beethoven. To do that, they gave it Beethoven's complete works, his sketches and notes. They taught it Beethoven's process—like how he went from those iconic four notes to his entire Fifth Symphony.

Then they taught it to harmonize with a melody, compose a bridge between two sections and assign instrumentation. With all that knowledge, the AI came as close to thinking like Beethoven as possible. But it still wasn't enough.

**Elgammal:** The way music generation using AI works is very similar to the way, when you write an e-mail, you find that the e-mail thread predicts what's the next word for you or what the rest of the sentence is for you.

**Carey:** But let the computer predict your words long enough, and eventually, the text will sound like gibberish.

**Elgammal:** It doesn't really generate something that can continue for a long time and be consistent. So that was the main challenge in dealing with this project: How can you take a motif or a short

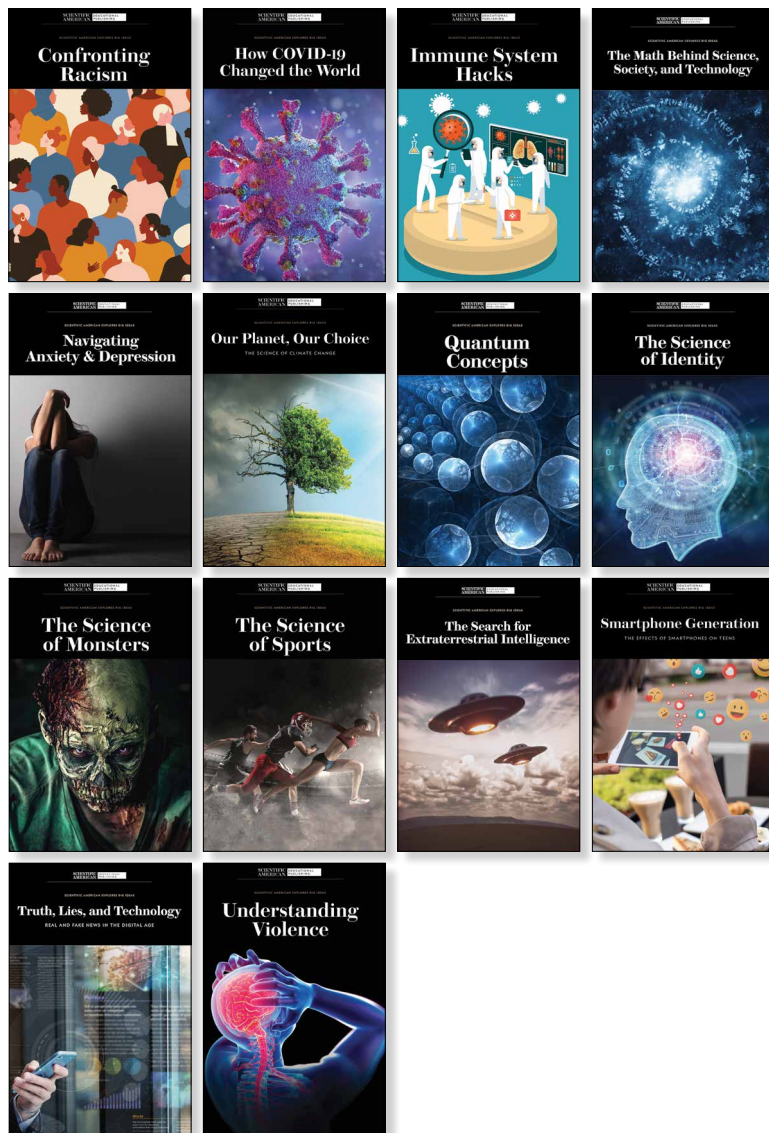

### Evolution Could Explain Why Psychotherapy May Work for Depression

A consensus has emerged in recent years that psychotherapies—in particular, cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT)—rate comparably to medications such as Prozac and Lexapro as treatments for depression. Either option, or the two together, may at times alleviate the mood disorder. In looking more closely at both treatments, CBT—which delves into dysfunctional thinking patterns—may have a benefit that could make it the better choice for a patient.

The reason may be rooted in our deep evolutionary past. Scholars suggest humans may become depressed to help us focus attention on a problem that might cause someone to fall out of step with family, friends, clan or the larger society—an outcast status that, especially in Paleolithic times, would have meant an all-but-certain tragic fate. Depression, by this account, came about as a mood state to make us think long and hard about behaviors that may have caused us to become despondent because some issue in our lives is socially problematic.

A recent article in *American Psychologist*, the flagship publication of the American Psychological Association, weighs what the possible evolutionary origins of depression might mean for arguments about the merits of psychotherapy versus antidepressants. In the article, Steven D. Hollon, a professor of psychology at Vanderbilt University, explores the implications of helping a patient come to grips with the underlying causes of a depression—which is the goal of CBT, and is also in line with an evolutionary explanation. The anolytic effects of an antidepressant, by contrast, may divert a patient from engaging in the reflective process for which depression evolved—a reason perhaps that psychotherapy appears to produce a more enduring effect than antidepressants. *Scientific American* spoke with Hollon about his ideas on the topic.

### Section 4: New Therapies and Lifestyle Changes for Anxiety and Depression

[An edited transcript of the interview follows].

**Q:** You described in your recent article the idea that humans evolved a propensity toward depression as a means to restore emotional and psychological equilibrium. That allows people to stay well integrated within their social milieus. So, can you explain how depression may be a product of evolution that can actually protect us?

**A:** In the late 2000s, I read a paper by the evolutionary biologist Paul Andrews. It was masterful, very thoughtful—and I totally disagreed with it. The main premise was that depression was an evolved adaptation that serves to make people ruminate.

**Q:** Why did you disagree?

**A:** For clinicians, we think of rumination as a terrible thing that at best is a symptom of depression and at worst leads to something that deepens the depression. We've always thought of it as a kind of exhaust out the tailpipe that is not really helpful. But the work of Andrews and his colleague J. Andrew (Andy) Thomson recounted that in our evolutionary past, what got you depressed was some kind of major problem—probably a social problem—that might get you excluded from the tribe. And what you had to do is sit down and think about things.

Most of us can think of anxiety as being a useful function, because anxiety takes us away from danger. It's quick, it's rapid, the reaction that occurs after stepping on a snake that might be poisonous when you're out in the woods. But most folks don't think of depression as having any function. It's just something unpleasant. The trick is to figure out what the purpose of depression is—and when Andrews and Thomson looked at what goes on when you get depressed, they found that a lot of energy went to the brain.

And the reason for that is to help us to think more carefully about the things that are going wrong, and first to understand what's the cause. That answers the question: How come I'm
