























Beethoven's Unfinished 10th Symphony Brought to Life by Artificial Intelligence

N early 200 years after his death, the German composer's musical scratch was pieced together by machine—with a lot of human help.

Werzowa: There were hundreds of options, and some are better than others. But then there is that one which grabs you, and that was just a beautiful process.

Carey: Ludwig van Beethoven was one of the most renowned composers in Western music history. When he died in 1827, he composers in Western music history. But that didn't stop people from trying.
