You can also use it closer to shore for kingfish, bluefish, and jacks. Some angless use chunt oa ttract fish to their boats when trolling. Drift fishing is similar to trolling, except that you "go with the flow" without a powered motor. By tructure fishing is popular for fishing from piers, docks, bridges, and other structures. The most commonly fished structure is a jetty. A jetty is a barrier made of rocks, concrete, wood, or rubble that sticks out into a body of water. To fish, you walk the length of the jetty. They can be uncen and slippery, so you need safety footwar called jetty creepers.
