Air Pollution and Illnesses According to the American Lung Association, pollution particles can be smaller than 1/20th the diameter of a human hair. This not only makes them easy to breathe in through the nose or mouth, but such tiny particles can easily enter the lungs as well. Breathing in polluted air is linked to more illnesses. It increases the risk of lung cancer, it irritates asthma, and it is linked to some types of heart disease. Polluted air has also been linked to stroke, asthma, diabetes, and lower IQ. A disease known as bronchitis tightens the pathways to the lungs and makes breathing difficult. During a time when Great Britain's air was very polluted at the turn of the 20th century, bronchitis was the leading cause of death there. Even with improvements in air quality over the past century, air pollution is still a serious cause of death around the world. According to the Environmental Defense Fund (EDF), air pollution causes 6.4 million deaths per year, and more than a half million of these people are children. Even with limits on outdoor air pollution, the World Health Organization (WHO) estimates that 300 million children live where air pollution is more than six times the international limits. Air pollution affects people differently based on age and location. Children and the elderly are affected the most by poor air quality because their lungs are still forming or may be weak. People living in cities or near busy highways are at a greater risk of disease due to air pollution.

IN THE MOMENT

JANUARY 11, 1970

In the days before Super Bowl IV, just about everyone expected the Minnesota Vikings to win their first championship. The Vikings had a great defense that allowed very few points. They were nicknamed the "Purple People Eaters." Their offense could also be overpowering. Minnesota was favored to beat the Chiefs by two touchdowns.

As kickoff neared, Kansas City coach Hank Stram and his players had heard enough about the Vikings. The Chiefs were eager to prove that they were the better team. The Vikings quickly learned that they were in for a long day. Buck Buchanan and Carley Culp clogged up the middle of the line of scrimmage, while Bobby Bell, Willie Lanier, and Jim Lynch made tackles all over the field. Johnny Robinson led the charge against Minnesota's passing game.

The Kansas City offense, meanwhile, was able to move the ball into range for Jan Stenerud to kick three field goals. The Chiefs were leading 9–0 when they recovered a fumble deep in Minnesota territory. Moments later, Mike Garrett scored a touchdown to increase their lead.

The Vikings fought back in the third quarter, but Len Dawson put an end to the comeback. He guided the Chiefs right back down the field for another score. The key play was a short pass to Otis Taylor, who broke two tackles and ran 41 yards for a thrilling touchdown.

Kansas City shut down the Vikings in the fourth quarter. Lanier, Robinson, and Emmitt Thomas each intercepted a pass. The final score was 23–7. The Chiefs were Super Bowl champions!

Ricky Walters, William Floyd, and Brent Jones added to the team's offensive firepower. Ken Norton Jr., Merton Hanks, and Deion Sanders were the leaders of the defense.

Following the 1994 season, the 49ers won Super Bowl XXIX for their fifth title. In the years that followed, the 49ers did not return to the Super Bowl, but they continued to play winning football. Young and Rice passed the torch to quarterback Jeff Garcia and receiver Terrell Owens. Charlie Garner and Garrison Hearst ranked among the NFL's best running backs. The defense welcomed young stars Bryant Young, Dena Stubbsfeld, and Julian Peterson.

During the early 2000s, the 49ers were unable to find their old magic. Players and coaches came and went without much success. Even so, the team continued to put stars on the field. Frank Gore ran for more than 1,000 yards year after year, while Patrick Willis was a fearsome linebacker. Under new coach Jim Harbaugh, the

49ers finally returned to glory. They played for the NFC title each year from 2012 to 2014 and made it back to the Super Bowl following the 2013 season. Their new stars included quarterback Colin Kaepernick and linebacker Na'Vorro Bowman.

In 2017, Kyle Shanahan became San Francisco's head coach. He led the team to the NFC title in 2018 and again in 2023. Receiver George Kittle starred for both conference champions. Other leaders on offense included Kyle Juszczyk, Deebo Samuel, Christian McCaffrey, and Brock Purdy, while the defensive standouts were Fred Warner and Nick Bosa. Although the team lost close Super Bowls both seasons, they reached the big game the "49ers way"—with hard work, smart play-calling, and amazing team efforts.
